When Jesus was of thirty, He came to John the Baptist for baptism, even though He had no sins, He humbled and submitted Himself. Jesus' baptism is the acceptance and the beginning of His mission as God's suffering Servant (Isaiah 53). He allowed Himself to be numbered among sinners. Jesus submitted Himself entirely to His Father's will.

Jesus came to give us the fire of His Spirit, that we may radiate the joy and truth of the Gospel to a world in desperate need of God's light and truth. Fire in biblical times was associated with God, and with His action in the world, and in the lives of His people. His word has the power to change and transform our lives so that we may be burning lights pointing others to Jesus Christ. Like John the Baptist, we, too, are called to give testimony to the light and truth of Jesus Christ.

The Father proclaimed His entire delight in His Son and spoke audibly for all to hear. The Holy Spirit, too, was present as He anointed Jesus for His ministry, which began that day as He rose from the waters of the Jordan river. Jesus will be the source of the Spirit for all who come to believe in Him. At His baptism, the heavens were opened and the waters were sanctified by the descent of Jesus and the Holy Spirit, signifying the beginning of a new creation.

The Lord Jesus is ever ready to renew and refashion us in His likeness through the gift and working of the Holy Spirit, and He anoints us for mission as ambassadors of His kingdom of righteousness, peace and joy.

The Lord Jesus wants His love and truth to shine through us so that many others may find new life, freedom and joy in the Holy Spirit. Let us ask the Lord Jesus to fill you with His Holy Spirit that we may radiate the joy of the Gospel to those around us. Amen.






