The Scriptures for today focus our attention on the importance and power of the Word of God and its challenge for us today. The Word of God being fulfilled in the ears of people shows us God's presence in our midst. In the Gospel, Luke tells us that his account is utterly believable because it comes from first hand witnesses, who knew Jesus personally, heard Him teach, saw His miracles, and witnessed His atoning death on the cross and His rising from the tomb to everlasting life. He writes the Gospel, which is a powerful and all-merciful word of God for us. It is a lifegiving word that has supernatural power to change, transform, and bring freedom and healing to those who accept it as the living word of God.

Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to His own land of Galilee and chose to publicly announce His mission in the synagogue at Nazareth. Jesus awakened their hope in God's promises when He announced that this word was now being fulfilled in His very own person. The people of His town were familiar with Jesus; they spoke well of Him and received His "gracious word" with amazement and wonder. But they also openly questioned how the "son of Joseph" would fulfill this Messianic mission.

The Lord Jesus speaks this same word to each of us, saying, "**Today**" this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." According to Luke, whenever he uses the word 'today' it has a connection with someone's life. It is a time to begin a new life in Christ, a moment of decision, a moment to take a new start and move on with Him. Jesus comes to bring us healing and restoration, pardon and freedom from the oppression of sin, despair, hopelessness and destruction.

May God grant us the Holy Spirit to follow Him with humility, and like Mother Mary, to be always available in service to others, Amen.


